



Troponin I – Change Of Units Of Measurement

Please note that as from 08:00 on the 2nd of November the units of measurement for Troponin I will change. This will coincide with the introduction of a new Acute Cardiac Chest Pain Protocol (ACCP) in Tauranga and Whakatane hospitals.

The rationale is that whole numbers are more user-friendly and reduce the risk for misinterpretation. In addition, this will bring the reporting units of Troponin into line with Waikato Hospital. Please note that results are assay (TNI/TNT) specific.

The new units of measurement will be nanograms per litre. The new cut off value will be 40ng/L.

The method of measurement of Troponin is unchanged and the cut off value is the same, just expressed in different units.
